

Immersive history lessons at the IPN Branch in Gdansk

From 4 to 14 March, the IPN Branch in Gdańsk hosted history lessons, where the basic tool was mobile boxes with immersive historical education. Young people participated in activities using educational projects of the Office of New Technologies of the Institute of National Remembrance, such as "Aviators", "Cipher Game" or "Testimony of Power". Engaging in learning through a well-known digital environment has convinced young people that learning can be fun. The vast majority of students expressed their willingness to continue this type of activity at school.
